

## Your Arrival in Japan

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### MEETING POINT: MAY 22 @7:30p, SHIBA PARK HOTEL LOBBY

If you arrive before 7:30p, you may check yourself in (under your own name or under “Yoshiko Wada’s Group”). Ask for an area map and explore Zojoji Temple, acquaint yourself with local area (very safe). There is a *konbini* (AM-PM or 7-Eleven type convenience store) across from the hotel and *ya-o-ya* (produce store) along a nearby small market street (ask concierge to mark your map). If you are late and the group has already departed for dinner at a nearby restaurant, Yoshiko will leave a note for you at the front desk.

### Getting from Narita Airport to Shiba Park Hotel:

Shiba Park Hotel is a medium-sized hotel whose location, service and personnel are excellent – from the bellhops (no tip necessary) to the helpful information desk. They have a coin-operated laundry and an ironing facility in the main building (not obvious, but ask); easy access to 3 metro lines and 1 JR line; nearby markets; and plenty of nearby dining options (though many are closed on Sundays). <http://www.shibaparkhotel.com/en/>

#### GETTING FROM NARITA AIRPORT TO SHIBA PARK

**By Shuttle.** Leave Customs area into the arrival lobby. Look for the (orange & white) counter for “Airport Limousine” shuttles. Tickets can be purchased at the counter. Buy a ticket for the particular shuttle / time. Buses leave from the arrival lobby on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor. Go to the curb, look for Shuttle bus signs and go to the number your ticket states. The baggage handler will give you a baggage ticket and will usually confirm your hotel name. <http://www.limousinebus.co.jp/en/>

(1) DIRECT. Check the shuttle schedule for buses going to Shiba Park Hotel. This is the most direct way to go but these buses run infrequently so you may need to wait. (Tickets to Shiba area ~JPY3000)

(2) SHUTTLE TO TAXI. Ask for the next shuttle leaving for “Tokyo Prince Hotel” as these run often and the hotel is very close to Shiba Park (“Shiba koen”) (there are many “Prince” hotels – the one you want is near Zojoji Temple in Shiba Park). Get off at Tokyo Prince Hotel ; take a taxi to Shiba Park Hotel. The bellhops at Tokyo Prince Hotel are very nice and will help you get a taxi. **By Train.** Leave Customs area into the arrival lobby. Look for direction to train platforms. Take train (either JR or Keisei airport line) to main JR Tokyo station. From Tokyo stn., either take a taxi (less than \$20) or transfer to JR Yamanote line or to Keihin line (same platform) towards Shinagawa. The third stop out is Hamamatsucho stn. Disembark train here, take the station exit towards Tokyo, go downstairs, and catch a taxi for the last few blocks or walk 15 minutes to Shiba Park Hotel.
